- Non-braking spaces are used:
 - After the last name and the first or each initial if they stand before the last name.
 - Before the slash sign.
 - After the acronym for the overall number of pages (“p.”)
 - After the acronym for the specific pages (“P.”)
 - After the number sign (“№”).
 - After the acronym “Iss.” (“issue”).
 - After the acronym for the volume (“Vol.”)
 - After the URL.
